Sighted land Round Island at 7 a.m. on our starboard
quarter.

Aug 17th Long. E. 98.47 Lat. S. 6.00 Passed Para
Rock and Pandarin Island.

Aug 18th Working up and down off Red Island a strong

current against us. at 9.20 a.m. a water spout was
observed off the Island. Passed Elephant Mount,
a small schooner passed us at 5.30 P.M. Prisoner
Hugh Henry taken out of the sweat box and taken
in the sick bay in a critical condition.

Aug 17th got up steam last night. dropped anchor
at 4 a.m. in 20 fathoms of water. hove up anchor
at 9 a.m. and commenced steaming running down
the Straits of Malacca. just in sight of the main
land numerous islands off our port bow. a large
turtle passed us on the port side in the afternoon.
At 1.30 P.M. all hands to muster and sentence of
court martial read.

Aug 21st Passed Sandel point Lighthouse. in the
afternoon a Malay pilot came along side and was
taken on board.

Aug 22nd Arrived in Singapore at 8.30 a.m. and dropped
anchor. The Delaware and Colorado are in here. fired a
salute of 13 guns. The Delaware hoisted her home ward
bound pennant and hove up anchor for the U.S. at
4.30 P.M. the Colorado saluted her with 13 guns. The
Delaware answered with the same number of guns
