

Jan 4th Sent down the top gallant and royal yards and top gallant mast and hoisted the top mast.

Jan 5th Sent down the lower yards, hove up anchor and went to sea.

Jan 8th Arrived in Kingpo having steamed all the way along the coast. U.S. Lt. S. Cocke is stationed here.

Jan 9th The American consul came on board and received the usual salute.

Jan 11th The Admiral of the Chinese navy and some other government officials paid a visit to the ship and received a salute of 3 guns on coming on board and a salute of 3 guns when leaving.

Jan 13th Went to sea under steam.

15th Arrived off Weesung.

17th Went out on a surveying expedition up the Yangtze Kiang, passed the French sloop of war Venus, we saluted the French Admiral with 13 guns, the salute was returned, went in company with a Chinese revenue steamer.

Jan 19th Andrew H. Harrington private marine died of consumption at 6 a.m. the guard raised at 6.

by subscription for a coffin and head stone.

Jan 20th Harrington's body was sent to Shanghai for interment.

Jan 21st Returned to Shanghai.

27th Harrington was buried with military honors at 10 a.m. in Potung cemetery.

Feb 14th Left Shanghai for Yokohama.

17th Passed some islands with burning mountains, redst. Sima, Morrison island, St. Clair island, Mount Horner, Valsana island, passed through Vandusen's strait.

Feb 18th Running under close reefed top sail, split the fore topsail.

Feb 19th Lat. 32.45, Long. E. 156. 01.

20th Lighted Fusi Jama. at 5.45 a.m. the sprays mountains at 6.15 a.m. Kuso Sima at 10 a.m. Ch. Sima at 7 P.M.

Feb 21st Arrived at Yokohama, the following men of war are stationed here the U.S. Ship Idaha, and Benico, Prussian Heertha and Medusa, French Alma and Dupetit, English Falk, Kingdove, Japanese Tho, the Mara.
